- Whole Bale – All bales used must be kept completely intact.
- Sculpted – Bales may be loose and sculpted into form (for example, using chicken wire).
- Professional – Any use of a professional artist used to make display.



Official Rules:

1. No entry will be eligible without a formal written entry form.
2. A large legible sign next to your bale with Title of Entry is required.
3. Displays must be visible from a city, county, or state roadway.
4. By submitting an entry form, you are granting permission to the Alliance to document, photograph and promote your entry in print, radio, social media and other promotions.
5. Displays must be located on private ground (not necessarily your own) by permission of landowner and should not limit vehicle visibility or in any way cause an obstruction of traffic. The highway road right-of-way must be observed and not infringed upon.
6. Square, round, loaf, loose hay or straw is acceptable.
7. Decoration materials are not limited in any way, shape, or form. Let your imagination run wild! Visit ExploreToddCounty.com to see pictures of some previous year's entries.
8. Return Entry Forms to address below or to Todd County Welcome Center, 1 Public Square, Elkton, KY.
9. **Prizes:** Will be awarded for: **1) Most Creative Display - \$250 Prize.** Awarded by group of judges. Professional category not eligible. **2) Fan Favorite Display - \$100 Prize.** (Awarded to most number of "Likes" of the official picture of the display posted on our Facebook Page by Noon on HarvestFest Day, Saturday, October 7th.) Winners will be announced on our Facebook Page on HarvestFest Day.
10. **Entries should be completed and on display by Monday, September 11th. We encourage you to keep the displays up until October 31st.**
11. An online map will be created and posted on September 18th on the ExploreToddCounty.com website for participants to "Explore Todd County" by visiting the bale sculptures throughout the county. This will give extra time to make sure the map is complete and correct.
